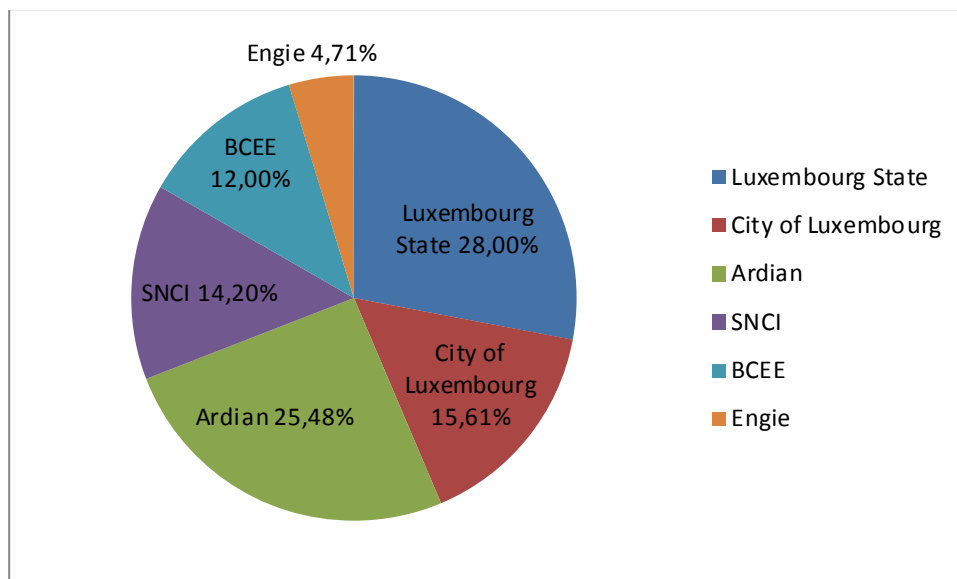




Change in shareholding structure of Enovos International S.A. as of March 7th, 2016

On 23rd December 2015, The Minister of Economy of Luxembourg, ARDIAN, RWE and E.ON announced a major change in the shareholding of Enovos International S.A.. A consortium led by the existing shareholders the Luxembourg State, the City of Luxembourg, the SNCI (Société Nationale de Crédit et d'Investissement), and ARDIAN, joined by the BCEE (Banque et Caisse d'Epargne de l'Etat) announced the take-over of all the Company's shares held by RWE and E.ON energy groups (28.36%). Closing of the transaction has been on 7th March 2016. An extraordinary shareholders' meeting of the Enovos International S.A. was held on that same date, amending the articles of association of the company and resolved the changes in the Board of Directors.
